Mozilla and Chrome add-ins to use when adding new websites to your Symbaloo mix. Free.

Samples of Use	Real time answers to posed questions in PowerPoint (2010, 2013, 2016) Multiple Choice or True/False
Description	Simple application that works well for live audiences using any device that has access to a web browser. The poll that is embedded within the PowerPoint presentation will update in real time and is anonymous. Free
Example	During an in-class or online lecture students can respond to questions asked on the slide by simply choosing a color to represent their answer. This works especially well when the instructor is gauging the level of comprehension of her students. Allows the instructor to customize learning activities on the fly depending on the poll results of the students.

Samples of Use	Competitive game play and/or discussion and survey
Description	Create, play and share fun learning games for any subject online. Kahoots are best played in a group setting, like a classroom. Players answer on their own devices, while games are displayed on a shared screen to unite the lesson. No downloads. Free
Example	Introduce new topics; challenge past performance; professional development; review, revise and reinforce; re-energize and reward; formative assessment; discussions and surveys

Description

Padlet is an Internet application that allows people to express their thoughts on a common topic easily. It works like an online sheet of paper where people can put any content (e.g. images, videos, documents, text) anywhere on the page, together with anyone, from any device.

Think of it like a multimedia friendly, free-form, real-time wiki.

Example

Teaching an online course or a large lecture style format where it's difficult to get to know your students? Post a Padlet to your Blackboard site and have students introduce themselves with pictures.

Samples of Use	<p>AnswerGarden is for anyone interested in using an easy and powerful way to get brief feedback from a group.</p> <p>AnswerGarden is used by teachers to establish the knowledge level of a class on a certain topic.</p> <p>It is used at conferences and workshops to break the ice with the audience in a fun and interactive fashion.</p> <p>AnswerGarden is used by creative teams for digital brainstorming sessions.</p> <p>People who maintain websites and blogs use it to poll their visitors in a brief and to-the-point matter.</p>
Description	<p>AnswerGarden is a minimalistic feedback tool. Use it in the classroom as an educational tool or at work as a creative brainstorming tool. Post it in a tweet or you can embed it on your website or blog to use it as a poll or guestbook.</p> <p>FREE.</p>
Example	<p>First create an AnswerGarden. Then copy the embed code underneath the AnswerGarden (click the Share-link first). Paste this code in Blackboard to include the AnswerGarden. AnswerGardens are a happy alternative for polls and comment-systems. The benefit of an AnswerGarden is that it limits the sometimes awfully long rants of commenting users while still keeping the expression lost in polls!</p>
