# Academic Integrity Violation and Sanction Classification Rubric

**Examples of violations - each case will be evaluated by trained members of each school**

- Level 1 violation
- Level 2 violation
- Level 3 violation

**Note:** A second violation will typically be classified as level 3 with a minimum sanction of suspension.
